Regular Meeting Minutes
Monday, March 14, 2016

Attendance: Mayor Lum, Council members Tonya Bush, BA Middleton, Don Roach and Teresa White, Danny Eudy absent, 4 employees and 4 guests. Mayor Lum called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Don Roach gave the invocation. Roll was called and quorum established
