ORDINANCE NO. 26-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BOGATA, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 01-25 REGARDING MANDATORY REFUSE COLLECTION SERVICES; DESIGNATING SANITATION SOLUTIONS AS THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE PROVIDER OF RESIDENTIAL REFUSE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICES WITHIN THE CITY; PROVIDING AN OPTION TO PARTICIPATE FOR CITY WATER CUSTOMERS LOCATED OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS; AMENDING THE PROVISION NUMBERED 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 01-25; REPEALING THE PROVISION NUMBERED 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 01-25; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS,

The City Council of the City of Bogata, Texas, has previously adopted Ordinance No. 01-25 establishing mandatory residential refuse collection services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that mandatory refuse collection promotes the public health, safety, sanitation, and general welfare of the citizens of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has granted an exclusive franchise for residential refuse collection and disposal services to Sanitation Solutions; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary to clarify the applicability of mandatory refuse collection requirements to customers receiving municipal water service outside the incorporated city limits and to eliminate provisions that are no longer applicable regarding vacation and temporary suspension of refuse service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOGATA, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Amendment to Ordinance No. 01-25.

Provision 1 of Ordinance No. 01-25 is hereby amended to read as follows:

1. Mandatory Residential Refuse Collection.

Every residence located inside the corporate limits of the City of Bogata and receiving a water bill from the City of Bogata shall be required to maintain a City-approved polycart and shall pay the applicable residential refuse collection fee for trash pickup service.

SECTION 2. Exclusive Franchise Provider.

Sanitation Solutions is hereby reaffirmed as the sole and exclusive provider of residential refuse collection and disposal services for all residential customers subject to this ordinance within the corporate limits of the City of Bogata. No other person or entity shall provide residential refuse collection services to residences subject to this ordinance unless specifically authorized by the City Council.

SECTION 3. Water Customers Outside the City Limits.

Residential customers receiving water service from the City of Bogata whose residences are located outside the incorporated city limits shall be afforded the opportunity to participate in the refuse collection service.

SECTION 4. Repeal of the Provision Numbered 3 of Ordinance No. 01-25.

The provision numbered 3 of Ordinance No. 01-25, relating to vacation service and temporary suspension of residential refuse collection service, is hereby repealed in its entirety. Vacation and temporary suspension of water services or residential refuse collection services shall no longer be available.

SECTION 5. Repealer.

All ordinances, resolutions, or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 6. Severability.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance, and the City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this ordinance without the invalid portion.

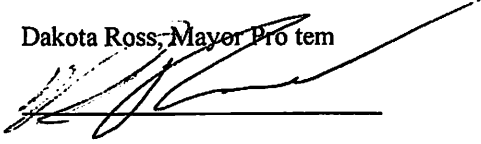
SECTION 7. Effective Date.

PASSED, APPROVED, AND ADOPTED by the City Council of the City of Bogata, Texas, on this 3 day of August, 2026.

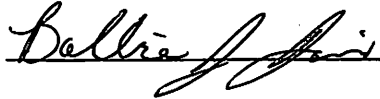
